

Volunteer Opportunities

Parenting Instructor: Provide support & education for those currently pregnant or who have children through our Earn While You Learn Curriculum. This opportunity allows you to serve as a mentor to the women we serve.

Mobile Unit Advocate: Serving as Patient Advocate on our mobile unit that will be parked outside of the abortion clinic, universities, and free health clinics. These appointments will be abbreviated, serving more as a “triage” versus a full-length appointment. We will have a monthly schedule for volunteers serving on the mobile unit (beginning Fall 2016).

Your First Look Mentor: We will be holding groups for our Your First Look clients. While we will have staff instructing these groups, we will also have each volunteer mentor serving 1-2 women participating in the group, digging deeper into their lives and serving as another support person in their lives. This would be a 1-day per week commitment throughout the length of the group and then will continue beyond the group setting via email, phone, Facebook, etc (beginning Summer 2016).

Administrative Projects: Provide support on administrative assignments and projects. Examples would be entering surveys, making packets for patient appointments, and data entry. As needed.

Special Events/Committees: Assist with annual banquet and women’s luncheon. Committee and day-of-event opportunities available.

Speakers Bureau: Speaking or being present at churches, community events, and outreach opportunities on Heartbeat’s behalf. Responsible for set up and tear down of items provided by Heartbeat. Commitment could be from 1-4 hours depending on event.

Welcome Desk Hostess: Welcoming visitors to Heartbeat at both our East Toledo & West Sylvania locations. Those participating as the hostess will be the first face those visiting Heartbeat will see. Commitment to one four-hour shift per week. Use of computer and copy machine necessary.

Baby Bottle Committee: Serve with others on the committee to organize the baby bottles (sorting, attaching tags, preparing money bags, etc) for assigned churches. Also, picking up and dropping off bottles to participating churches. Opportunities periodically throughout the year; not a consistent weekly volunteer position.

Sparkle Crew: This important opportunity allows those with the gift of helping and organization to keep our facility clean and beautiful for our clients. The ability to lift and stand are necessary. All cleaning supplies are provided by Heartbeat.

Data Entry: Input charts and client information into our database. Not a consistent weekly volunteer position.

Nurse: Responsible for performing the pregnancy test, collecting health history and providing educational materials for early pregnancy. Should have a basic knowledge of early fetal development or be willing to learn.

Sonographer: Responsible for performing limited ultrasound via transvaginal and transabdominal ultrasound. Limited ultrasound is used to determine viability, gestational age and intrauterine pregnancies.
